The Leaving Care Act has two main aims:

- 1. To ensure that young people do not leave care until they are ready
- 2. To ensure that they receive more effective support once they have left

LOCAL AUTHORITIES NEW DUTIES UNDER THE LEAVING CARE ACT

Aged 16-18:

- Duty to ensure pathway plan is in place by 16th birthday
- Duty to make assessment and meet needs
- · Duty to provide financial support
- Duty to provide Personal Adviser
- Duty to ensure accommodation

Aged 18 and over (up to the age of 25 if you wish the support to continue)

- Duty to maintain contact and to provide support through Personal Adviser
- Duty to assist with costs of education, employment and training
- Duty to ensure you live in suitable accommodation

KEEPING IN TOUCH

If a Local Authority loses touch with a care leaver it must try everything to get back in contact with the young person, and to do so until contact is achieved.

ACCOMMODATION FOR CARE LEAVERS

- The leaving care act requires that all care leavers are provided with or maintained in suitable accommodation.
- Housing needs must be addressed before the Young Person leaves care as part of the pathway plan.
- It is important that both housing and Social care play a full role in providing support.
- Accommodation must be reasonably practicable for the Young Person given his/her needs.
- It is not legal for 16/17 year olds to have their own tenancy agreement. This can only happen when they reach 18.
